NOW Ministries has been in existence for 2 years. In that time we have grown from

supporting less than 100 National Pastors and Missionaries to more than 600 in 34 different countries. One country in which we are helping to support Pastors is the country of Malawi, Africa. Malawi is in the southeastern part of the continent of Africa and is presently going through one the worst famines in our world. Over 50% of the citizens of Malawi are starving to death, with thousands dying everyday. Their only hope is the Gospel of Jesus Christ.

Three years ago, there were only 3 Independent Baptist Churches in the country of Malawi. One retired pastor from the United States went over and begin training the Nationals to reach out through Evangelistic Crusades, and to start churches. To date, 166 churches have been

started and over 100,000 have been saved. The national Pastors of Malawi are reaching their country with the hope of the Gospel.

Because of the poverty in Malawi, and the famine, it is impossible for the churches to support their pastors. With no money, and no food, they have nothing to give. For only \$20.00 US per month a pastor can reach out to his village and the surrounding areas with the Gospel. NOW Ministries is presently supporting 107 National Pastors in Malawi, but we have the names of an additional 150 Pastors in Malawi and Mozambique who need help now. Their situation is desperate and without your help millions of people have no hope! Partner with NOW Ministries and bring hope to the millions in these two countries who are lost without Christ. The workers are in place, we have the power of the Gospel, but we are short of funds needed to keep the pastors in their churches. Malawi is a hot and barren place, but one thing it has plenty of, is people. Everywhere you look there are people. As you leave the

City of Blantyre and enter the country side you see fields plowed by hand, (no tractors), ready to plant, and thousands of people. As you drive, you see hundreds of mud bricks, thatch roofed huts, and people, thousands of people.

Pastor Farrington and I were privileged to visit many of the churches where NOW Ministries supports national Pastors. Some were still in the process of being built, some were completed, and still some were meeting under a shade tree. Over 166 churches have now been started in Malawi, and the supporters of NOW have had a big part in their birth.

On Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, we preached in one village where a church had been started about a year ago. The service on Friday night was late in starting, but the people patiently waited for the service to begin. People were scattered throughout the darkness, listening to the preaching of God's

Word. The service went to well after midnight. We were back on Saturday for 3 services that day. Thousands of people came and hundreds were saved.

The scripture is so true when it says *The harvest truly is plenteous, but the laborers are few;* "(Matt. 9:37). So many people to reach, and yet their are just not enough laborers to harvest the souls that need to be reached with the Gospel. In just 3 days over 951 souls were saved, just think of the millions who could be won if we had the funds to support more National Pastors so they could reach their people with the Gospel.

- S 374 were saved.
- S Sunday Morning 636 people attended the service.
- S 83 were saved.
- S 53 were saved in other services in other locations
- S In Total 3224 people attended the services where we preached and 951 were saved.
