504 Saved in 4 Days

The Pastor's Conference this year was the greatest conference I have ever been a part of on the Island of Cuba. Not only were the Pastors and Missionaries excited to see us, but each church was prepared for the services each evening. The team of 21 Pastors, Evangelists, Missionaries, and Laymen traveled every night to different churches to preach the Gospel of Jesus Christ. In 4 days, 48 evangelistic services were held, and we preached to over 4,500 people. God moved in a mighty way in each service and a total of 1,049 decisions were made. 504 of those decisions were for salvation. The people of Cuba were rejoicing and in the Conference there was talk of Revival. What a blessing it would be to see Revival break-out in Cuba.

One service in particular, in which I preached, was in Bejucal, where Mario Delgado is the Pastor. The song service was fantastic, the people of Cuba love to sing. Once the introductions were made, it was my time to preach. The auditorium was packed. I counted at least 456 people and there were more standing outside.

Pastor Mario speaks English very well and so he interpreted my message. I presented the Gospel as simple and plain as I knew how. The invitation was given and many people began to come forward. This is very hard for the people of Cuba, because for so long they were afraid of the government. That evening, 12 people accepted Jesus as Savior. Many also came to make other decisions for the Lord. It was a wonderful service. After the service, Pastor Mario told me that all those that accepted Christ that night were in church for the first time in their lives. They had been praying for some of these people for many years.

For 4 days we held the Pastor's Conference in the morning and then preached in 9 different churches in the evening. Each preacher did a wonderful job and there were reports of scores of people being saved. The Pastors of Cuba said "you have defiantly made an impact on the people of Cuba."

In the last 6 years, over 100 new churches have been started by men NOW Ministries supports. Six Bible Institutes are now in operation, and soon a Bible School will be finished, out of which we will be able to ordain our graduates. Please continue to be a part of this ministry that is reaching the Island of Cuba for Christ.

The Conference was held in Trinidad, Cuba and was hosted by Pastor Enoc and the members of his church. Every possible effort was made to make this conference a blessed time of fellowship and revival for the Cuban Pastors.

Each Pastor and Evangelist that was a part of the Conference did an excellent job of instructing and encouraging the Cuban Pastors, and Missionaries. The messages were inspiring and uplifting, but above all, the emphasis was that we were all joined together, in one accord, to win the Island of Cuba for Christ.

For six years, Evangelist Toru Marshall has been taking support into Cuba to help the Pastors and Missionaries who are struggling to reach their people with the Gospel. There certainly is a great need, and without our help many will be lost for eternity. One Pastor made this statement, "Brother Marshall, we are

very thankful for the monthly support. It has helped us do far more for the Lord than we ever thought possible. However, if you ever have to choose between sending the support or having the Annual Conference, please never stop coming and sharing with us in the Conferences."

The Pastors of Cuba are starving for love and encouragement from the Churches in America. NOW Ministries is filling the gap, helping to keep the Cuban Churches open and preaching the Gospel.

- ♦ Over 1000 responded to the invitations.
- ♦ In all, 504 people accepted the Lord as their personal Savior.
- ♦ Bibles were given to many of the new Converts.
- ♦ A trip was made on horseback to the Missions in the Escambray Mountains.
- ♦ 21 Pastors, Evangelists, Missionaries, laymen and their families accompanied Brother Marshall and Robin on the trip.
- ♦ More than 150 attended the Pastors Conference every day.
- ♦ 3 New Bible Institutes were started.
- ♦ Plans were made to start a Bible College to train Pastors.
- ♦ Over 100 New Churches and 6 Bible Institutes have been started.
- ♦ Presently 105 Pastors and Missionaries are being supported monthly.
- ♦ Support is still needed for 3 Pastors and 12 Missionaries @ \$30.00 a month.
