One of the greatest thrills for me is to Preach the Gospel and see lost souls come to Christ. This year I was privileged to go to 6 foreign countries and preach Evangelistic Crusades in 4 of those countries. The

results of those meetings were what make this ministry worthwhile. Below are a few highlights from each country.

Cambodia

In early October Dr. Pete Rice and Mark Logan accompanied me to Cambodia to preach a Pastors Conference and many Evangelistic meetings. Every day we traveled to churches in different cities to Preach. One church was a ministry to Vietnamese refuges. The place was packed with people who had escaped the Communist Government of Vietnam trying to find a better life in Cambodia. The faces of the people showed the hardships they had endured and when the invitation was given over 50 came to except Christ.

One of the most exciting places we preached was a little village about 2 hours from Phnom Penh. There was no church in this village, but a local Pastor had a burden to start a church there. We rented a tent, a sound system and took some cookies to give to those who came. After making our way down a dirt road and Oxen paths we arrived to find the tent full of people. Nearly the entire village came to hear the Americans, almost 150 adults and children. The sound system was loud enough to be heard by the next three villages. Dr. Pete Rice preached a simple Gospel massage and 90 adults responded to the invitation. The local Pastor took the children across the road and talked to them and reported many of them received Christ also. The pastor was very excited, because now he has a good group of people to start a church in that village.

Each day brought new opportunities to preach the Gospel and encourage Native Pastors in their ministries. A three day Pastors Conference was hosted by NOW Ministries at a local camp. The Pastors were challenged to win souls, plant churches and disciple new believers. In all 551 People accepted Christ in Cambodia.

Philippines

From Cambodia I traveled to Philippines for five days. While there I preached in a two day Pastors Conference hosted by NOW Ministries, participated in a Medical Mission hosted by NOW Ministries, preached in several churches, schools and Preached a one night Evangelistic Crusade. The one night crusade was a great success. Even though is rained all day a great number of people came to fill the stadium that had been rented for the occasion. The Vice-Mayor of Bulacan came and gave a good testimony of his salvation. Ricardo Garcia's church provided the music and then I preached. God moved in a wonderful way with 194 receiving Christ that night. In total 494 were saved through my preaching in Philippines. I plan to return this year and preach 3 Crusades in different cities. <u>Malawi</u>

In late November and early December I was in two different countries of Africa. First was Malawi, where NOW Ministries is helping to support over 200 pastors in remote villages. The first few days I helped Mark Logan preach in Pastors Conferences in two locations. These pastors desperately need encouragement

and financial help. Several days were spent traveling to villages to preach Evangelistic services and also to check on the construction of a new orphanage. One night we traveled about 45 minutes from the town of Blantyre to a remote village where we were showing the "Jesus Film" and then I would preach. In the dark it was hard to count how many were present, but I was told over 350 came. Preaching to Africans in total darkness is quit unique. But as I preached God moved in their hearts and 176 came to Christ. In all 373 people were saved through my preaching in Malawi

Congo

My last stop for the year came in Congo (DRC); a country that has been destroyed by war over the last 50 years. A great missionary and good friend Gail Dawson invited me to come and preach an Evangelistic Crusade. They had never done this before and were a little unsure of the outcome. Because of the danger after dark all the services had to be finished before 6 PM. It was an open air meeting during the rainy season. The rain threatened every night, but not one drop of rain fell until after every service was completed on the last night. Great crowds attended every night and hundreds responded to the invitations. In all 637 people were saved. The Bible College students helped with the counseling, transportation, music and basically anything that was needed. The Crusade was well organized and very successful. One night the Mayor came and spoke of how thrilled he was that someone would take such a great interest in his town. The Chief of Police got saved, several town officers also and a Methodist Pastor and his wife came and received Christ. Out of the Crusade I was told two or three churches will be started and the church that sponsored the meeting has already increased its attendance by 50%.

For the entire year, here in the United States and on the Mission field 2,493 people came to know Christ, because you partnered with us to take the Gospel around the world. I am praying for even more salvations this year. Pray with me, as I will be in many meetings here in the U.S. and in six foreign countries. Thank you for your prays and Support!
